

Mini-Bus Driver / Trip Leader

The County of Augusta has opening(s) for a Mini-Bus Driver/Trip Leader position in its Parks and Recreation Department. This staff position provides off-site leadership for trip programs. The staff member transports the participants to the specified place of interest and acts as the group chaperone. They provide aid where and when needed. The work is not under immediate supervision and requires attention to detail. The majority of the work will involve interaction with the senior adult population.

Knowledge, Skills & Abilities:

Qualified applicant must be able to establish effective working relationships with community, volunteers, general public and other staff. Applicant must be able to follow directions and possess the ability to manage risk while providing great hospitality.

Applicants must be 18 years of age, possess a valid VA driver's license and have an acceptable driving record.

Education & Experience

High school diploma or GED and one year of experience in operating a shuttle, passenger or larger bus or vehicle; or any equivalent combination of acceptable education and experience providing the knowledge, skills and abilities cited above.

Wage/Salary

This position is a part time position with no County benefits. Starting wage is \$9.50/hour plus some meal reimbursement and admission to trip venues. The work schedule will vary based on planned trips and outings but will include some weekday, weekend and evening hours.

Candidate will have to go through a criminal background check and drug screening. DMV driving record will be requested at time of employment. Employment is dependent on a satisfactory test drive on the bus.
