## General Guidelines

To help every participant have a positive experience in the Augusta County Community Academy (ACCA), we ask for your cooperation in following these program guidelines:

1. **Please be on time.** Our departments have a lot of information to share! We need to start promptly to cover all topics and allow for questions and answers. Please arrive 5-10 minutes early.
2. **Let us know if you're going to be late or absent.** If you will not be able to attend a class or will be significantly late, please contact us as soon as possible at [academy@co.augusta.va.us](mailto:academy@co.augusta.va.us) or call us at (540) 245-5610 (before 5 pm).
3. **Leave your family at home.** While we understand that emergencies arise and babysitters fall through, please keep in mind that many of the classes and tours are not child-friendly. We also want to avoid disruptions to presenters and participants.
4. **Be respectful.** We all have different points of view. Please be courteous and civil to your fellow participants, presenters and staff, regardless of differing opinions.
5. **Ask questions during the Q&A period, but avoid personal grievances.** This is your chance to hear directly from the people who do the work, and our presenters welcome your questions during the designated Q&A period. That said, **this is not a time to air personal grievances.** If you have a concern with one of our departments, please bring it to our attention outside of class and we will address it with you.
6. **Attend at least 5 of the 6 classes.** If you fail to attend at least 5 classes, you will not be eligible for a certificate of completion.
7. **Silence your phones.** As a courtesy to your neighbor and the presenter, please silence your cell phone while classes are in progress.
8. **Be honest.** We'll be sending you a brief evaluation survey after each class. Your candid and constructive feedback will help us make ACCA worthwhile for current and future participants.
9. **Have fun.** This program is about you. Enjoy yourself, make new friends and discover Augusta County!
