**Motions Day Information:**

- Praecipes for cases ending in odd numbers (1, 3, 5, 7, 9) should be filed for the first Motions Day docket of the month, which typically falls on the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday of the month.
- Praecipes for cases ending in even numbers (0, 2, 4, 6, 8) should be filed for the second Motions Day docket of the month, which typically falls on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of the month.
- If your matter has multiple cases/case numbers, the lowest case number will control the Motions Day for which the case should be filed. *i.e., Case number CL26000001-00 and CL26000004-00 would defer to the lower case number, CL26000001-00, and would accordingly be filed for the first Motions Day of the month as the ending number is "1" and is odd*
